

HOMECOMING 1972

Howard W. Pollock, deputy administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and a 1941 Perkiomen graduate, became the third person inducted into the College Hall of Fame.

The 52-year-old Pollock, who grew up in New Orleans and homesteaded in Alaska at the age of 32, is currently serving his fifth state gavel statewide. He is the only Alaskan in history to serve in the territorial legislature, the state legislature and the U. S. Congress.
