

The interdenominational George County Center, a \$1.2 million Christian Center at Sissonville, was dedicated on October 20, 1973. The Center, which includes a gymnasium, swimming pool, a cafeteria, library, auditorium, and a 140-seat theater, is the first of its kind in West Virginia. It is the result of a joint effort by the George County Board of Education, the George County Commission, the George County Chamber of Commerce, and the George County Interdenominational Christian Center.


