- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the MGCCC College Admissions Requirements
- \_\_\_\_\_ Visit the Health Care Assistant Program Website page (located under Programs of Study/Nursing & Health Professions).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Make application to the college by visiting <https://mgccc.edu/enroll/apply-now/>
- \_\_\_\_\_ Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for Campus Police testing times.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Prior to the deadline, but after successful completion of the above program entry requirements, submit the supplemental Health Care Assistant Application. (See website for steps on submitting the application).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Review the online mandatory Pre-Health Sciences Orientation Session by visiting Web Services and entering the GCID and Password. The PowerPoint can be found under Student/Health Sciences Division Supplemental Application Orientation Session. The session can be viewed anytime and anywhere internet is accessible. The presentation gives you valuable information on topics common to all health science programs at MGCCC. The information is approximately one (1) hour in length.

- **Fall Semester Application Deadline:** July 1<sup>st</sup> (Applications accepted beginning April 15<sup>th</sup>)
- **Spring Semester Application Deadline:** November 1<sup>st</sup> (Applications accepted beginning August 15<sup>th</sup>)
- **Summer Semester Application Deadline:** May 15<sup>th</sup> (Applications accepted beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>)
