This scholarship is renewable up to **four consecutive semesters**, including summer.

- Enroll in and complete a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester
- Continuing students must maintain a 3.0 and summer 2018 entering freshman a 3.2 or higher cumulative grade point average and complete the 15 semester hour requirement.

## ACT Score 21-24

- Legal Resident of Mississippi
- Enroll in and complete a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester
- Continuing students must maintain a 2.5 and summer 2018 entering freshman a 3.0 or higher cumulative grade point average and complete the 15 semester hour requirement.

## ACT Score 20

- Legal Resident of Mississippi
- Enroll in and complete a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester
- Maintain a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average and complete the 15 semester hour requirement.
