

STEP-BY-STEP APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR THE

Physical Therapist Assistant STUDENT

Upon satisfactory completion of the program, students are awarded the Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant and are eligible* for PTA license examination.

- _____ Complete the MGCCC College Admission Requirements
- _____ Visit the Physical Therapist Assisting Program Website page (located under Programs of Study/Health Sciences).
- _____ Review and Complete the **Mandatory** Pre-Health Sciences Orientation Session (*See website to access*)

Register for and successfully complete the following Prerequisites

- _____ Complete **BIO 2514, Anatomy and Physiology I AND BIO 2524, Anatomy and Physiology II**
- _____ Have a minimum cumulative (GPA) of 2.5 on college work with no grade less than "C" on any Academic Core* courses in the current PTA curriculum. (Courses may be re-taken and highest score will be used).

* Academic Core courses include: BIO 2514, BIO 2524, MAT 1313, ENG 1113, SPT 1113, a Humanities/Fine Arts Elective and a Social /Behavioral Science Elective

- _____ Achieve a minimum composite score of 18 or above on the ACT (Enhanced Version - Fall of 1989 or later). A score of less than 18 will not be accepted and cannot be waived.
- _____ Register for and complete the HESI A2 Exam (Check Physical Therapist Assistant website regarding Registration, Testing, Remediation, and Re-testing)
- _____ Student must complete and document 40 hours of Clinical Observation in the field of Physical Therapy.
- _____ Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
- _____ **Prior to the deadline, but after successful completion of the above program entry requirements, submit the supplemental Physical Therapy Assisting Application. (See website for steps on submitting the application). Contact an Enrollment Specialist at a campus of your choice for additional questions.**

Application Deadline: November 1 (If deadline falls on a weekend, holiday, or closing, the deadline is 5 p.m. on the next college business day).
