

FAQ – NAVY BASE

I'm not a Mississippi resident, do I have to pay out-of-state fees?

No. To remove the out-of-state fees you will need to turn in a copy of your current military orders.

I'm not taking classes, but my spouse is, will they have to pay out-of-state fees?

No. Just provide us with a copy of your orders that also lists your spouse and this will remove the out-of-state fees.

Is MGCCC accredited?

Yes. MGCCC is accredited by the Mississippi Commission on College Accreditation and by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

Do you have payment plans?

Yes. Payment plans with three due dates are set up in the spring and fall and with two in the summer.

I'm not active duty and do not have a DOD card, can I take classes on the Navy Base?

Yes. You will need to fill out a background check form (provided by the Education Representative) and turn it in the Pass/ID Office. Once you are cleared, you will be issued a pass to attend class on the Navy Base.

Do I have to drop a class if I get deployed?

Not necessarily. Your instructor can issue you an "I" for incomplete and once your return, you would complete your coursework and then your final grade would replace the "I". If completing the course is not an option then you would need to start the military withdrawal process by turning in a copy of your deployment letter and complete a military withdrawal form. The funds will be reimbursed to the appropriate parties if applicable.

Can I pick up books and turn in my tuition voucher in your office?

Yes. Once you turn in your voucher, the education representative will post it to your account. You can also turn in your voucher at any of the campus business offices. If you are taking a class on the Navy Base, you may pick up your book from the MGCCC education representative on base, or at any of the campuses.

Do I need to make an appointment to see you?

No. I have an open door policy, not appointment necessary.

Do you offer weekend classes?

Yes. We offer weekend hybrid classes which are a blending of traditional in class instruction with an on-line component. The classes meet a total of four times on Friday and Saturday.

Do I have to attend all four sessions for the weekend hybrid classes?

Yes. These are intense classes that cover a lot of material in a short period of time. All four sessions must be attended.
