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
## What is Degree Works?

- Automated advising tool
- Encourages collaboration between advisors and students
- Provides students with important information on degree progress
- Provides access to self-advise throughout the year



## Logging into Degree Works

- Go to Web Services
  - Log in using GCID and password
  - Look under Student Tab
    - Click Registration
    - Click on Degree Works
- Available to Students Nov. 2





## Degree Checklist – the Default view


- Made up of sections or blocks of information
  - Personal information
  - Degree progress
  - Degree Review

    - Note: These last two are reverse order for some CTE programs


- Degree progress wheels

### Degree Review

- Clear list of what is done and what is lacking in progress toward degree
- Color-coded legend at the bottom of the page
  - Green = complete
  - Red = incomplete
  - Blue = in-progress

- The 15-hour Academic requirements for AAS degrees
- Attributes link to classes acceptable and offered during next semester







#### What-if view


- Useful to show how a change of degree or change in area of interest affects progress toward degree
- Useful for those looking to earn AA and AS degrees






#### Icons

  - Course History








## **GPA Calculator and Course History**

- Three options for Calculator
  - Graduation Calculator
  - Semester Calculator
  - Advice Calculator

Course History is essentially an unofficial transcript





#### Notes

- Advisors enter, but students can see them
- Advisors encouraged to leave a note every time they meet with a student to document the interaction
- Students will see Notes at the bottom of the page


## Other viewing option: PLANS
