- Obtain a Criminal Background Check from a MGCCC Campus Police office. The CBC result is required prior to submitting the application. Please check the program's website for the Campus Police testing times.
- Optional; additional points towards admission ranking will be awarded for successful completion of the following academic core course: ENG 1113, PSY 1513, CHE 1214 or 1314, SPT 1113, and a Humanities/Fine Art Elective
- _____ Optional; Phlebotomy (ASCP) Certification (Additional points will be awarded to those who hold this certification)
