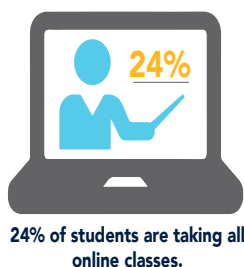

ATHLETICS



MGCCC boasts 200+ student-athletes competing in 12 varsity sports and excelling in the classroom. In 2025, the college won the Halbrook Award for highest graduation rates in both men's and women's divisions and had 127 student-athletes named to MACCCC All-Academic teams, with 20 earning Academic All-District honors.



Through the Mississippi Artificial Intelligence Network (MAIN), MGCCC has awarded: 1,319 CEUs, 250 SEMIs, and 89 OSLs (or a total of 1,658 professional development credits) and has provided 15,000 total instructional hours for K-12 teachers.
